

The Performers and Entertainers Guild of Lochac

Charter

1. Purpose of the Guild

The purpose of the guild shall be to:

- Form a network of people with a shared interest in dramatic and performing arts and other forms of entertainment
- Encourage interest in, practice, and study of all kinds of performing arts and entertainment.
- Educate, encourage and foster an awareness of performing arts and entertainment within the populace

2. Membership of the Guild

3. The Guild Clerk (Provost of Entertainers)

- a) The Guild Clerk is the administrative head of the guild, and shall be a guild member in good standing.
- b) They shall be responsible for announcing and coordinating the processes of electing their successor and altering the Charter (see section 4 below); administering the online presence of the guild; and reporting on the status of the guild to the Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences.
- c) The Provost may appoint deputies as needed to support them in their duties.

4. Election of Guild Clerk and Alteration of Guild Charter

- a) Election of the Guild Clerk, or alteration of the Guild Charter, shall be by a vote of guild members following a notice period of at least 4 weeks.
- b) If the Guild Clerk is unable to fulfil their duties, the members of the guild may consult the Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences to manage the transition to a new Guild Clerk.

5. Guild Challenge Logbook and Titles in the Guild

- a) Guild members may choose to challenge themselves and reflect on their development by participating in the 'Guild Challenge Logbook'.
- b) Guild members may optionally participate in a system of titles that encourage demonstrated skill and improvement in the fields of activity covered by the guild. They may, if they choose, call themselves a 'guild apprentice' or 'guild journeyman', as a recognition of which challenges they have completed in the 'Guild Challenge Logbook'.
- c) To recognise the members of the guild who have contributed greatly to performance and entertainment in Lochac, they may be named a 'Guild Master' by acclaim of the guild.
